



Dr. Theodore Brown Sr. is a graduate of Oakwood University, Amberton University and Andrews University. At Oakwood University, Brown is an Associate Professor of Management in the School of Business, and an Adjunct Professor of Leadership in the School of Education at Andrews University. He also serves Oakwood University as the Faculty Exchange Coordinator and Consortium of African Adventist Universities and Partners (CAAUP) Coordinator. Brown also served as an Adjunct Professor of Management at Brookhaven College.

Dr. Brown earned the PhD in Leadership with an emphasis in Financial Leadership and Management from Andrews University in 2005, and has taught numerous traditional and online courses in leadership and management.
